

Consultations require the payment of a fee, the price of which, €38.71, is defined by the "Regione Lombardia" (Lombardy Region). In the case of families or groups, the cost of consultation is applied only once for up to 3 adults, while it is always free for minors. In any case, it is important that a booking is made for every single person.

All vaccines, with the exception of those already provided free of charge to the general population (e.g. anti-Diphtheria-Tetanus-Pertussis "DTaP"), are subject to payment according to the regional tariff which can be viewed on the Service's web page.

Payment is to be made at the location where consultation is provided by debit or credit card (<u>cash</u> <u>is not accepted</u>).

- Consultations are free for those carrying out volunteer trips and humanitarian missions. Proof of such travel from the sending association/nonprofit organisation is required. Vaccines must however be paid for.
- Those who travel abroad for adoption purposes are exempt from all fees relating to consultations and vaccines. Also in this case, documentation of the international adoption agency is required.

The "Servizio di Profilassi del Viaggiatore Internazionale" (International Travel Health Service) is aimed at all those who intend to travel abroad. The Service provides, through consultations carried out by specially-trained healthcare personnel, information regarding:

- the specific risks for the travel destination in consideration of the areas visited, the period in which you travel, the length of stay, the health conditions of the traveler etc;
- the behaviors to adopt to reduce the risk of infectious and non-infectious diseases (water and food hygiene, prevention of insect bites, altitude etc);
- the vaccinations recommended for the trip;
- antimalarial medication, if necessary.

Access to the Milan International Travel Health Service is **BY APPOINTMENT**.

Bookings are made for residents and those domiciled in the Municipality of Milan. For municipalities outside Milan, contact your local vaccination center or consult the website of your "ASST" (local health service) of residence.

Access to the service WITHOUT AN APPOINTMENT is reserved ONLY for those who need a duplicate of the international yellow fever vaccination certificate and for those who need to start or continue POST-exposure antirabies vaccination (following a wound at risk of rabies).

It is advised to bring along the documentation relating to your state of health (previous vaccination certificates, any diagnosis of pathological conditions and ongoing therapies).

In the case of last-minute travel for work, volunteering or international adoption reasons, travelers (including <u>non</u>-residents/domiciled in Milan), who are unable to book an appointment through the Regional Call Center within 15 days of departure, can visit the office in Via Statuto, 5.

The Service will do its best to assist travelers on the day of their unannounced arrival at the office, otherwise they will be given an appointment for the closest possible date.

These travelers must be in possession of adequate documentation certifying the reason for the trip.
